IT'S KITTEN SEASON



WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND KITTENS:

Mama cat might be hunting for herself if you find kittens alone. She likely has not abandoned them!

If she doesn't return after 10+ hours, check to see if the kittens are well-fed and warm. If they are not sick, injured or in danger leave the kitten where it's sittin (with mamma) until they are eating and walking independently.

Taking newborn kittens to the shelter should be a last resort.

Eyes still closed or just beginning to open:
1-2 weeks old



Eyes open & alert, becoming mobile:
2-4 weeks old



Very mobile & often talkative, can eat food:
4-6 weeks old



Very active & playful, weighs 1-2lbs:
6-8 weeks old



Very active & playful, weighs 2lbs or more:
8+ weeks old
